

Band Booster Club Scholarship

This scholarship has been established by the Shawnee Heights High School Band Booster Club. This scholarship consists of a monetary grant of an amount to be established each year by the Band Booster Club. The scholarship will normally be awarded to one graduating senior in any academic year.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1) A graduating senior at Shawnee Heights High School, having been enrolled in Marching band, Symphonic band and/or Concert band for at least seven (7) semesters.
- 2) Earning a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 and at least a 20 on their ACT.
- 3) Enroll in a degree-granting postsecondary education program within three (3) months of receiving the scholarship.
- 4) The Band Director will verify that these eligibility criteria are met for each candidate who submits an application

Selection Criteria:

Scholarship recipient(s) will be selected from among eligible applicants through a process controlled by the Shawnee Heights Public Schools Foundation. The Foundation selection committee will consider the “whole person” when making selection decisions. Important factors that will be considered, in order of relative importance are:

- 1) The band student’s participation and attendance at all the various band activities.
- 2) The band student’s record of extra-curricular activities, especially community service-related activities.

Application Process:

Band students must complete application to the Band Director. The Band Booster Executive Board will review the applications to ensure that the band student meets eligibility criteria for the scholarship and then submit qualifying applications to the Shawnee Heights Public Schools Foundation.

Awards Process:

Scholarship recipients will normally be announced at the Band Booster Banquet, at which time the recipients will be awarded a monetary amount determined by the Band Booster Club.

Application Deadline:

Applications must be received at the High School Counseling Center **no later than 3:00 P.M. on March 2, 2020.**
